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## TH 87 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## PROJECT OVERVIEW

- Trunk Highway 87 will be improved from the Highway 10 Interchange to Menahga
- Work will begin in Fall 2020 and end in Fall 2022
- Project includes a combination of improvements aimed at safety and infrastructure improvements, including a multiuse trail and ADA improvements in Frazee

## RURAL PROJECT: TREE CLEARING

Project Boundaries: North River Drive in Frazee to Menahga (28.6 miles)
Date of Construction: Winter 2020


## Proposed Work

- Tree clearing along roadway ( 65 ' on each side from roadway centerline) to improve safety

## TH 87 IMPROVEMENT PROJECT

## RURAL PROJECT: SHOULDER WIDENING

Project Boundaries: North River Drive in Frazee to CR 41 in Evergreen ( 12.2 miles)

Date of Construction: 2021


## Proposed Work

- Pavement reclaimation (full depth reclaimation) to improve ride condition
- Shoulder widening to accomodate pedestrians and bicyclists
- Bridge/box culvert replacements at Otter Tail River, a drainage ditch near County Road 33, and Toad River
- Flattening inslopes

## RURAL PROJECT: PAVEMENT RECLAIMATION

Project Boundaries: CR 41 in Evergreen to east Becker County line (14.5 miles) Date of Construction: 2021


## Proposed Work

- Pavement reclaimation (full depth reclaimation) to improve ride condition

Project Boundaries: County Highway 29 to North River Drive (1.4 miles)
Date of Construction: 2022


## PROPOSED WORK

- Pavement Rehabilitation/Mill and Overlay
- Full Roadway Reconstruction
- Construction of Multi-Use Path
- City Utility Improvements

1 MILL AND OVERLAY SEGMENT
(From County Highway 29 to 105th Street)
2 CAUSEWAY SEGMENT
(From 105th Street to 2nd Street )
3 SOUTH RESIDENTIAL SEGMENT
(From 2nd Street to the railroad tracks)
4 DOWNTOWN SEGMENT
(From the railroad tracks to the alley between Main Avenue and Ash Avenue)

5 NORTH RESIDENTIAL SEGMENT
(From the alley between Main Avenue and Ash Avenue to Birch Avenue)

6 SCHOOL SEGMENT
(From Birch Ave to River Drive)

## URBAN PROJECT: RESIDENTIAL SEGMENT

Segment Boundaries: From 2nd Street to the railroad tracks


PARKING ON NORTH SIDE

+ Parking: Parking is maintainedRoad Centerline Shift: Significant centerline shift
- Impact to Sight Distance: Sight distance at 2nd Street is not improved
- Lane Width Consistency: Consistency of 12 lanes can not be carried throughout corridor, which may be an issue with oversized vehicles and snow plows


PARKING ON SOUTH SIDE
Parking: Parking is maintained from 2nd Street to Maple AvenueRoad Centerline Shift: Minor centerline shiftImpact to Sight Distance: Sight distance at 2nd Street is improved

- Lane Width Consistency: Consistency of $12^{\prime}$ lanes can not be carried throughout corridor, which may be an issue with oversized vehicles and snow plows
- Parking: No parking from Maple Avenue to Juniper Avenue


NO PARKING

- Parking: Parking is eliminated
+ Impact to Sight Distance: Sight distance at 2nd Street is improved
+ Lane Width Consistency: Consistency of thru lane width is carried throughout corridor
+ Impact to Walk and Trail: Fewest number of impacts to walk width and trail buffer
- Pavement Section: Wide pavement section
