

### Link Tool

- 1.) Click on the Link tool. It looks like a chain.
- 2.) Drag your cursor to the map you want and left click.
- 3.) A pop up window will appear.
- 4.) Depending on how many maps are in that location you could have multiple options.
- 5.) For a TIF file. Click on the plus sign. You will have three options.
  - A. View ROW in Autoview.
  - B. Download ROW map.
  - C. TFW Right click "Save as".

Choose the option you want.

- 6.) You can also left click on the "Show on the map" button. This will highlight the footprint of the map you chose.
- 7.) For a DGN file. Click on the plus sign. You will have two options.
  - A. View ROW in AutoVue
  - B. Download ROW map

Choose the option you want

There will also be a Public Land Survey option. This will give you the Section, Township and Range.

To turn off the Link tool. Left click on the Link icon.
