

FINDING A RW MAP IN EDOCS

eDOCS is another website you can use to find a RW map. (Link to EDOCS website [EDOCs](#))

1. On the left hand side of the eDOCS site click on the text that says Right of Way maps.
2. The search box will show up. Here is where you can type the map number.
3. You can still do a search for a map, if you don't know the map number.
4. Click on the gray rectangle with 3 little dots to the right of the map search box.
5. A window will open. Click on the pull down menu next to the text that says filter.
6. You can look up a map by control section, trunk highway, county, and ect.
7. We will be looking up a RW map by control section.
8. From the pull down menu select control section and type in control section 3103 and hit the apply button.
9. You will get a list of maps in that control section. Once you find the map you want. Click on the check box next to the map number. Then click on the blue ok text on the top right.
10. Next you will click on the perform search button.
11. Under document name you will see your map in blue text. Double left click on the blue text to open the RW map in Auto Vue.
