

## **Right of Way Mapping and Monitoring (RWMM): Known issues and anticipated improvements**

The Office of Land Management is always looking to improve our customers' experience. As part of that effort, we continue to develop technologies used to deliver our products and services. This document provides a list of known issues and anticipated improvements for the RWMM application. If you encounter any issues not listed below, please let us know.

### **Section corner survey records no longer available**

Section corner survey records are no longer available through the RWMM application as of February 9, 2018. A replacement solution is being considered. In the interim, survey records such as certificates of location of Public Land Survey corners, section breakdowns, and survey notes are accessible through the eDIGS application: [eDIGS Application](#)

### **File format for R/W Plat and Graphic Commissioner's Orders**

All right of way plats and graphic commissioner's order documents are maintained and delivered in a TIF format. For some records, an optional PDF format of the file may exist. The PDF format files are temporary and will be removed in the near future.

### **Scale issues on long maps in PDF only**

Map sheets exceeding 200 inches in length do not maintain their true scale in PDF format. This is due to limitations in the PDF specification.

### **The map selection pop-up**

When clicking in any footprint within the application, the resulting pop-up window used to select a map cannot be moved. This is a known issue for all ArcGIS Online products. To see behind the pop-up simply close the window (X in the upper right hand corner) or click in a different location on the map. You can use the "Marker" option found in the ellipsis dropdown in the lower right corner of the pop-up.

### **Batch downloading of map files**

The ability to batch download map files is currently not available within RWMM. This will be considered as a possibility as part of future enhancements.
