- 27 payments have been made
- A total of \$20,885,465 has been reimbursed of the \$144,262,254 granted
- In the current drawdown (#5)
 - There are seven pending payments totaling \$135,749
 - There are five rejected totaling \$448,871
- There are currently 11 payment requests pending, some with MnDOT some with the requestor
- According to our data, reimbursement is taking an average of 52 days, from request to payment
 - Many factors affect processing time

Takeaways

- Use the CARES [reimbursement submittal form](#) found on MnDOT's website
- Review the language in the M&O amendment
 - Pay particular attention to the priority of payment provisions (federal funds utilized first)
- CARES funds will pay for more than what is eligible for state reimbursement under the M&O program
- Consider submitting large or full amount submittals to reduce the overall amount of processing necessary
 - However, do not submit requests for more than the full grant amount
- Review both [MnDOT](#) and [FAA FAQs](#), paying particular attention to FAA's documentation requirements

- Tracking document showing grant and drawdown status to be posted next week and will be updated every other week
- MnDOT has combined AIP and CARES reimbursements in drawdowns to increase efficiency and size
- Staff capacity will remain a challenge but continuing to mitigate where possible

Where to find MnDOT's CARES Act info

Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act (H.R. 748, Public Law 116-136)

The CARES Act is a federal program that provides funds to eligible airports to address the financial impact of COVID-19. FAA rules on CARES Act funding may be found on their website: https://www.faa.gov/airports/cares_act/. The FAA has also posted a list of frequently asked questions to provide further guidance on eligible expenses and minimum documentation requirements. Questions that are not addressed here should be directed to the FAA Program Manager for clarification.

Please scan your entire payment in PDF format. This must include the signed credit application and all supporting invoices. Attach the document in an email to airportdevelopment@state.mn.us. In the subject line, enter your airport's identifier code (IDENT) and the state project number which is found on the top of your credit application. Example: HIB 6902-C1.

Don't forget:

- Did you use the correct credit application? State M&O forms will not be accepted for CARES submissions.
 - Is the credit application signed and notarized?
 - Is the required backup provided? Reference the FAA's frequently asked questions page for more information.
 - Are the expenses within the permissible time frame?
 - Operations costs after **January 20th** (prorate or sort out ineligible costs)
 - New development expenses after **March 27th**
 - Debt Service after **March 27th**
 - Is the total request less than the grant amount. Requests that exceed the remaining amount on the grant will not be accepted.
